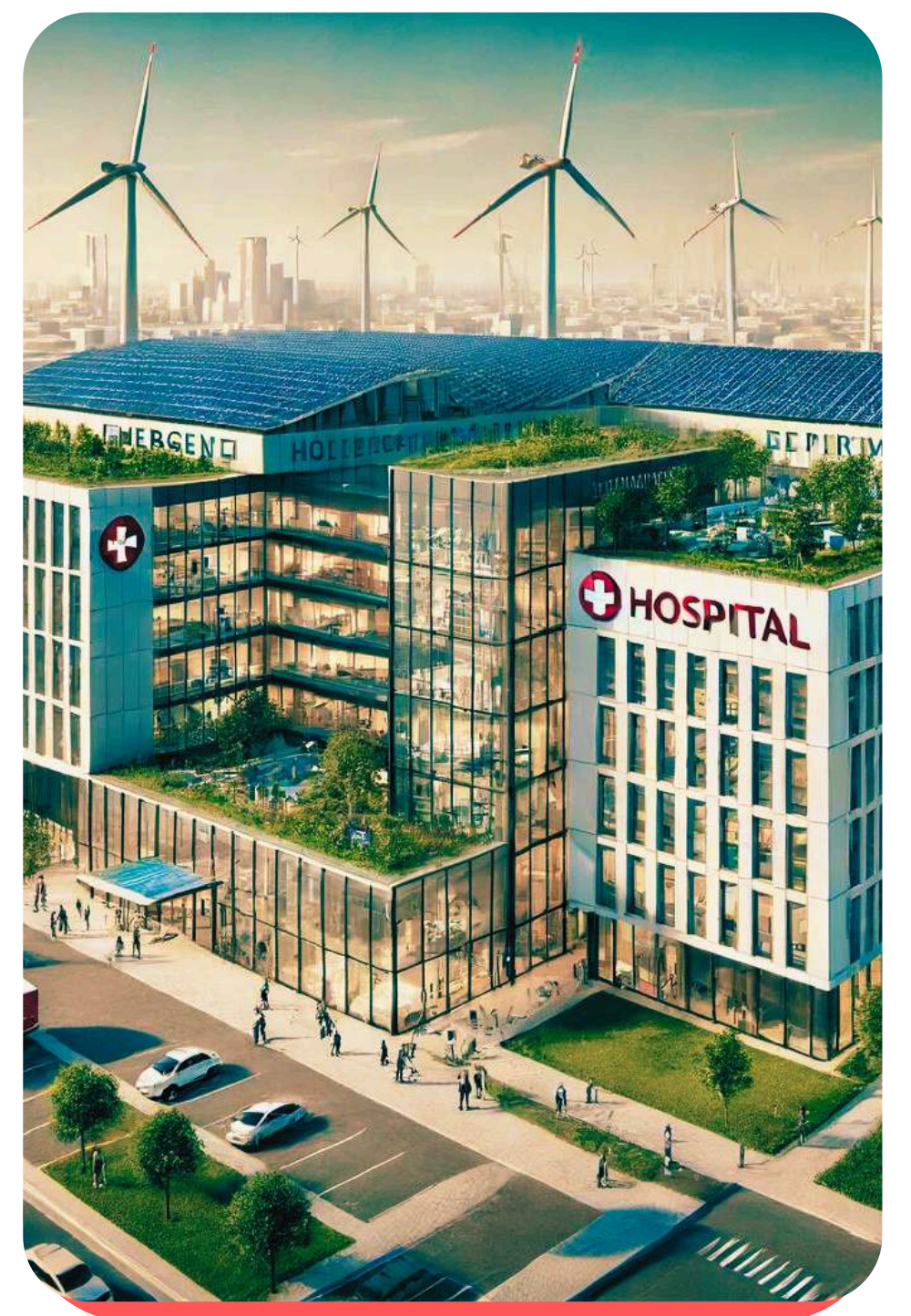

Foreword: Climate change is a major health threat, affecting Uganda through floods, droughts, and temperature changes. The Ministry of Health, guided by the Vulnerability & Adaptation Assessment (VAA), has developed the H-NAP to build a climate-resilient health system. This plan calls for collaboration across sectors to address climate challenges.

Vision: A responsive, adaptive, and resilient health system that protects and promotes the health and well-being of the people of Uganda.

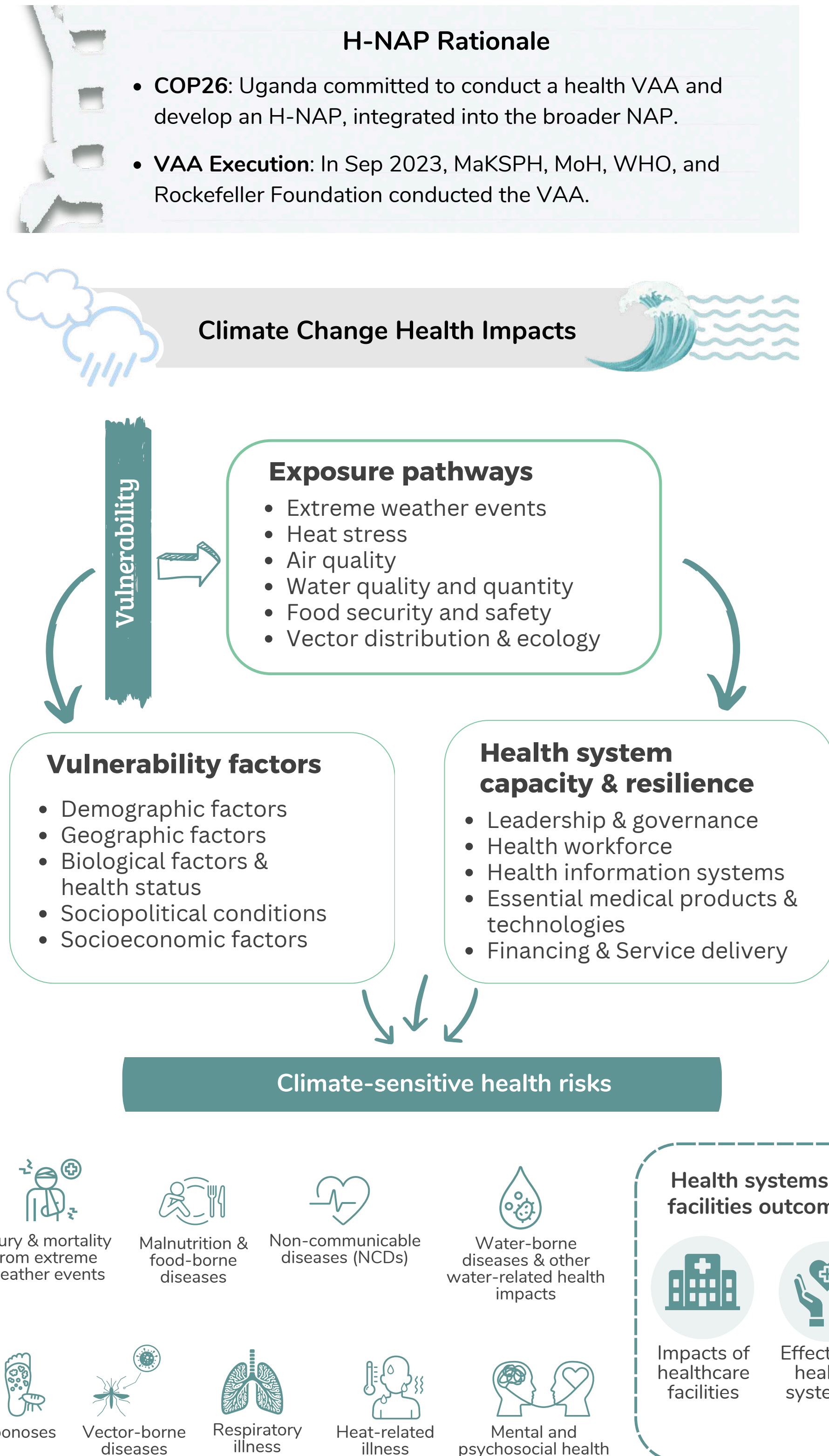
Mission: Establish a responsive health system that promotes inclusive Climate Change Adaptation measures.

Goal: To strengthen the adaptive capacity of the health system to climate change and related hazards.

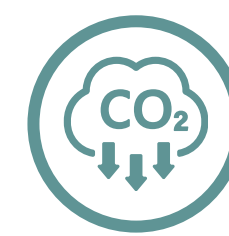
H-NAP Rationale

- **VAA Execution:** In Sep 2023, MaKSPH, MoH, WHO, and Rockefeller Foundation conducted the VAA.

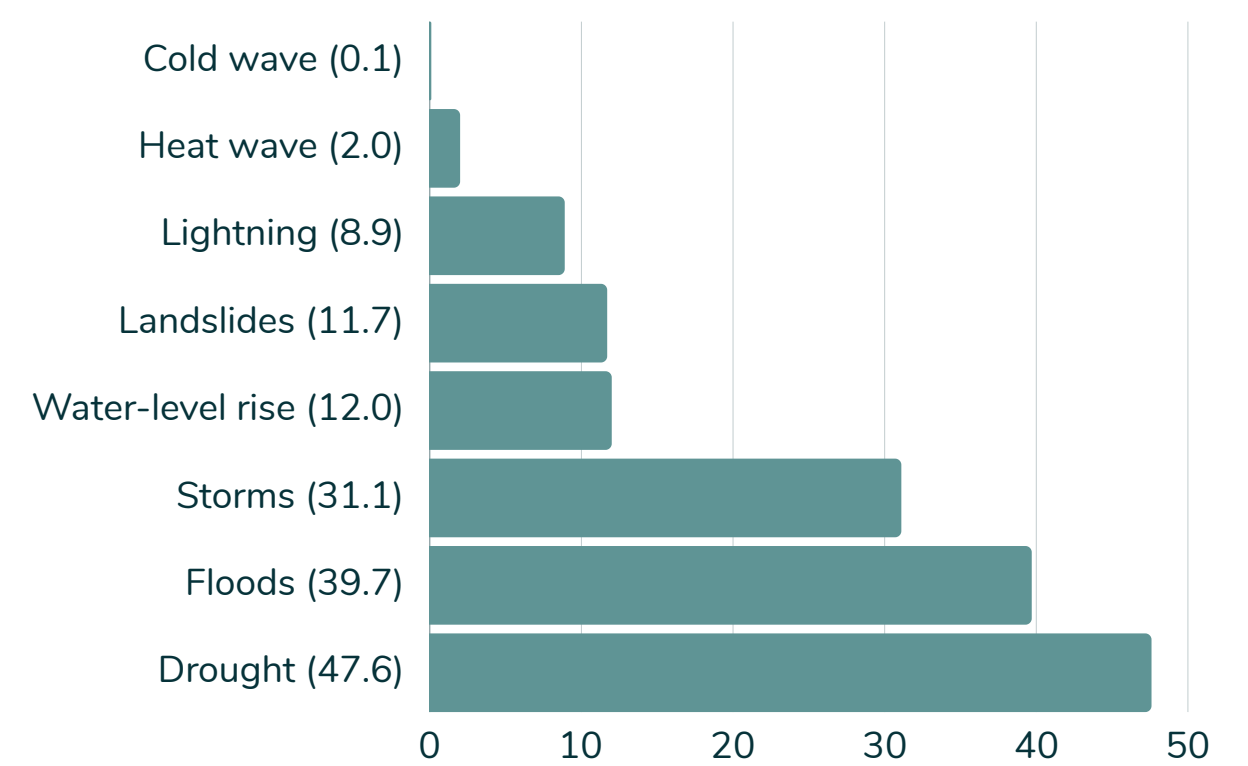
Climate Change Health Impacts



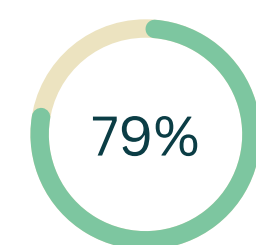
Vulnerability and Adaptation Assessment (VAA)



EXPOSURE TO CLIMATE RELATED HAZARDS



Vulnerability: A significant proportion of the Health facilities exhibited high vulnerability to climate change-related hazards because they were unprepared for the different exposures.



HWS IMPACTED BY FLOODS

H-Workforce: Inadequately involved in climate adaptation plans, poorly prepared for outdoor work during extreme conditions, and lack proper PPE and training to manage climate-related health impacts.

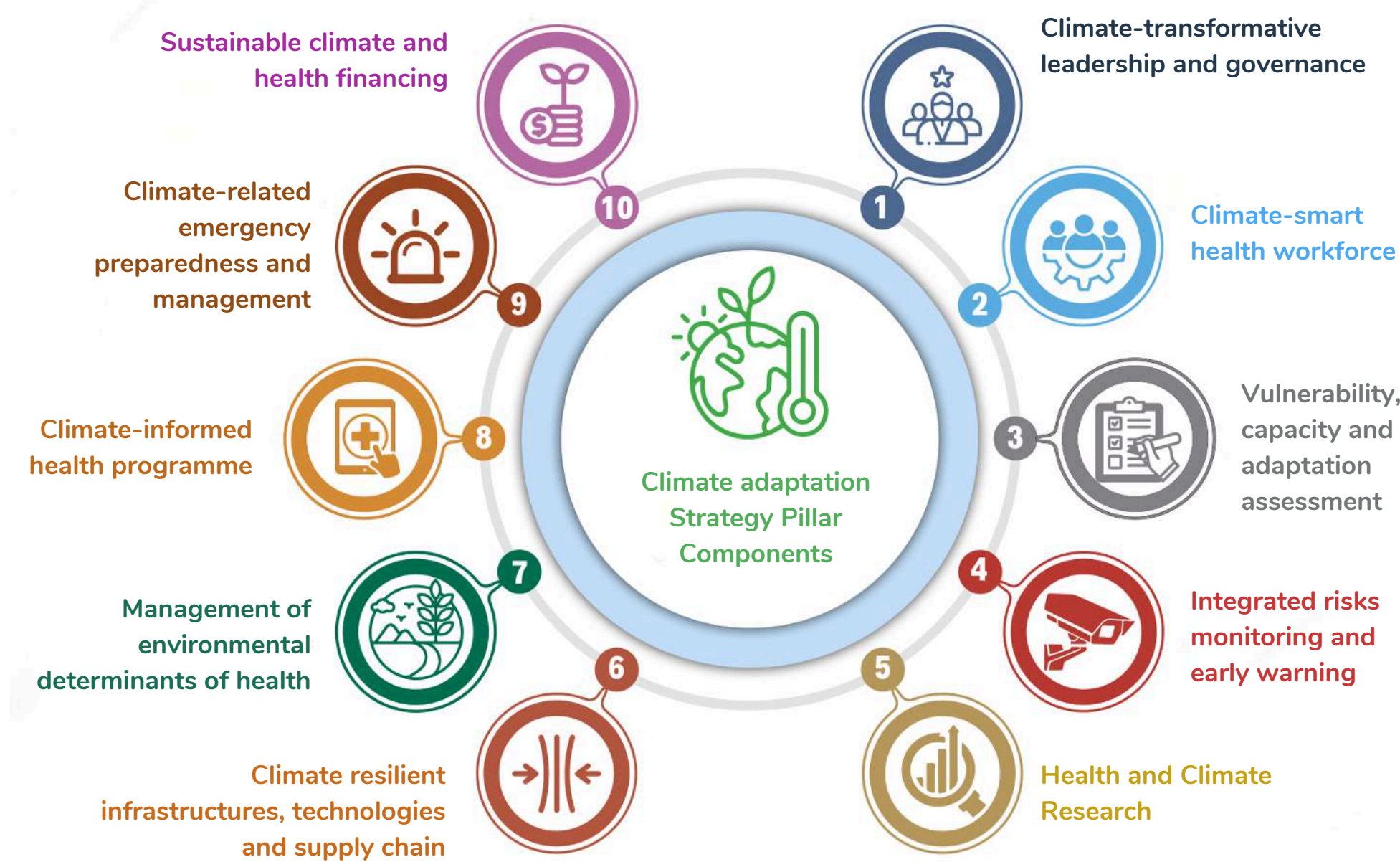
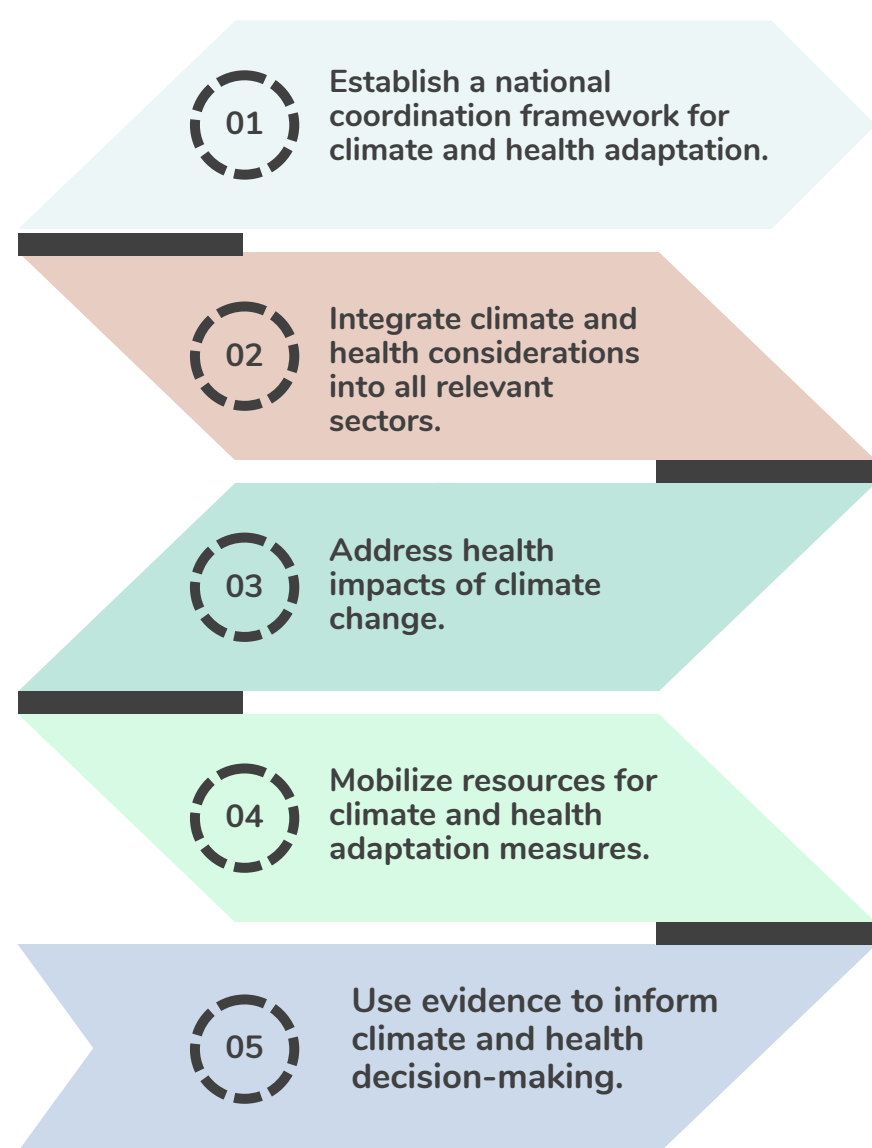
WASH & Infrastructure: Inadequate strategies for water safety, vector control, and hazardous waste management in healthcare facilities, along with insufficient plans for post-hazard recovery, protection of critical equipment, and secure evacuation during emergencies.

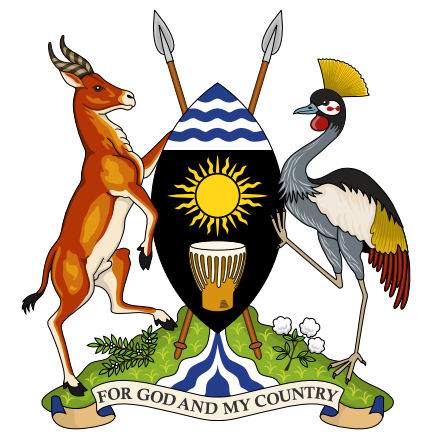
